

# Christmas Door Hanger



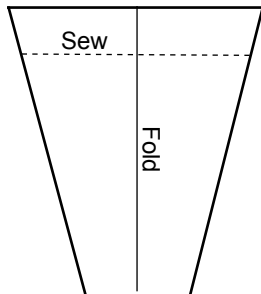
*It* all starts with a vertical design postcard. If you don't have one that'll work, go to [www.twistedpapers.com](http://www.twistedpapers.com). You'll find the postcards in this project there, they have a *huge* selection. Printing on glossy photo paper gives a nice, crisp image. Hang these on a doorknob, dresser knob, dress up a present, in front of a mirror or a simple decoration for a wreath.

*Materials:*

- Postcard with vertical design
- Fabric scraps
- Batting scrap
- 3 Bells

*How to:*

1. If postcard is printed, sand the corners lightly so they're slightly curved.
2. Sew Dresden Plate. Print the last page for templates.



Cut 12.



Fold in half.



Sew along dashed line.



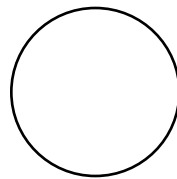
Trim seams.



Turn right side out and press.



Sew together and press all seams in same direction.



Cut 1 from freezer paper.



Iron to fabric and baste. Applique to center of Dresden and leave in paper.

3. Cut two fabric and one batting at 1 ¼" wider x 4" longer than postcard. From same fabric cut one at 1 ¼" x 20".



4. Fold 1 ¼" x 20" in half lengthwise and press. Fold raw edges toward fold and press. Sew long edges of tie.



5. Fold in half and lay on right side of fabric, centered. Pin in place. Lay second piece on top, right sides together.
6. Lay fabric on top of batting. Sew around edges, leaving an opening opposite tie.

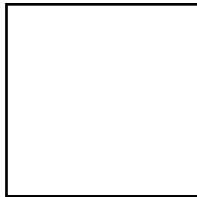
7. Turn right side out and handsew opening closed.
8. Machine or hand quilt around edges.
9. Glue or sew postcard and Dresden on.
10. Sew 3 bells along bottom in contrasting thread.

*Options:*  
use an old photograph instead of a postcard, vintage trim instead of bells or a collage of vintage buttons instead of the Dresden Plate.

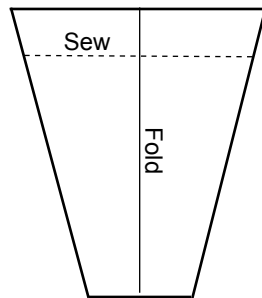

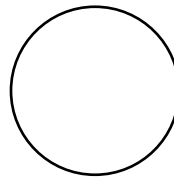
# Templates
